A police SWAT unit entered Isaiah's house on June 7, 2017. Isaiah was dead within minutes. The police did not produce a search warrant for almost 6 hours.

Police claim Isaiah fired an AK-47 at them. The family claims the gun, which was legally purchased, did not work.

A forensic expert who examined the house found no evidence that any guns were fired toward police. All bullet holes appear to have been made by fire from the police.

Bullet holes in the floor show police fired at Isaiah after he was already down.

Isaiah's grandfather, a Vietnam Veteran, states Isaiah retreated from his own bedroom to his grandfather's room, got the disabled man out of bed and onto the floor to protect him from incoming fire, and said that he did not know who was attacking the house.

Isaiah's grandfather states Isaiah had no gun while in the bedroom or when he left it. He was shot almost immediately thereafter.
